VIRTUS/PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN FOR ADULTS FAQ'S

• What is a Safe Environment Program?

A Safe Environment Program details ways by which entities may create and maintain a safe environment for children. The program selected by the Catholic Diocese of Richmond is, *Protecting God's Children for Adults* provided by VIRTUS.

What is VIRTUS Training?

VIRTUS is the brand name for the safe environment program used by the Catholic Diocese of Richmond. This is in accordance with the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*, article 12. The VIRTUS training program used in the diocese is *Protecting God's Children for Adult*. This is session for adults to learn ways to protect children from child sexual abuse.

Who is required to attend Virtus?

All employees, clergy and volunteers working with minors are required to attend a VIRTUS session.

How do I get information on Virtus?

How do I register?

To register go to http://www.richmonddiocese.org/VirtusTraining.htm. When registering, be sure to list the parish or school you are affiliated with. If you do not have computer access, please ask your parish/school for assistance.

When do I need to complete Virtus?

VIRTUS training should be completed before you begin your volunteer role or at point of hire.

• What if I have attended a Virtus session in another diocese?

Please contact VIRTUS at 1-888-847-8870 to have your training information transferred to the Catholic Diocese of Richmond. Note, when calling VIRTUS provide the customer service representative with a current email address, home address and phone number.

What if I have taken a similar sexual abuse training class?
Per Diocesan Regulations, volunteers, employees and clergy are required to attend a VIRTUS session.

• Is there follow-up required?

Yes, monthly online bulletins are sent to your account or information can be printed and provided to you at you request. A reminder is sent by email each month notifying you of the bulletin posting.

• Are there age restrictions?

VIRTUS sessions are designed for those over the age of 18. Individuals age 16 and 17 can attend with written permission from their parents.

• How will my parish or school know I have attended?

Shortly after attendance, your name will appear in the VIRTUS database. When registering be sure to list the parish and or school location(s) you are affiliated with.

• Do I have to take the training more than once?

Attendance at a training session is required one time.
